

DOMAINE SAINT MICHEL ROSÉ

This proprietary pink wine is sourced from three vineyards owned by the Boyer family and situated between the Cévennes Mountains and the Mediterranean Sea in the picturesque Côtes de Thongue appellation. Expect a bright, lively glassful of red berries, tangy grapefruit and steely mineral and sip with pan-fried rainbow trout or salmon.

Grape varieties: Grenache Noir, Syrah.

Description: Blush and bright peach rose color. spicy aromas. Subtle and harmonious in the mouth, very elegant.

Yields: 45 hl/ha.

Winemaking process: Traditional, at low temperature. Direct press, then the juice is cooled and left on the heavy lees to extract aromas and allow the lees to separate from the juice before fermentation.

Ageing: 4 to 6 months in tank before bottling.

Food & Wine Pairing: Serve at 10-12°C with Mediterranean or summer cuisine,
